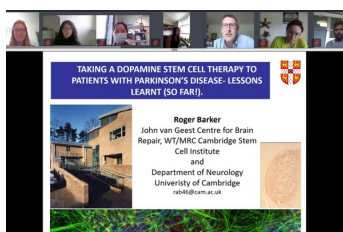
„Connecting Stem Cell Scientists in NRW“ – the motto of our new virtual exchange format

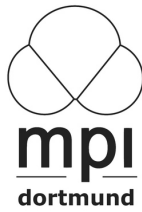
Positive response to virtual discussion format „Ask the Stem Cell Expert“
