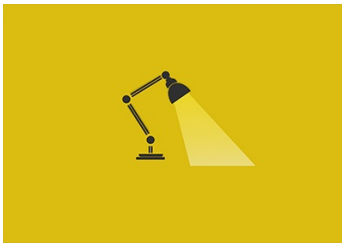
Save-the-Date: 12th International Meeting of the Stem Cell Network NRW
