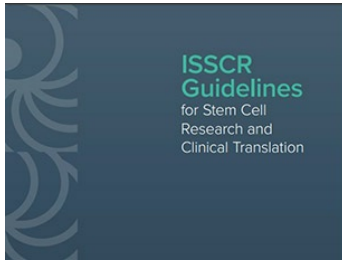

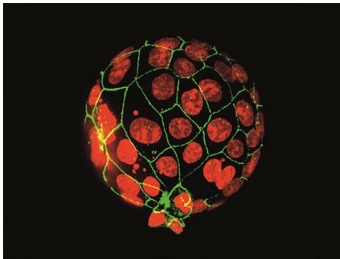
ISSCR publishes revised Guidelines for Stem Cell Research and Clinical Translation

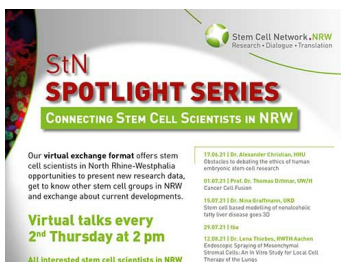
New info hub for online gene and cell therapy

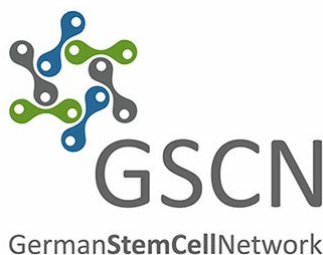
StN Spotlight Series offers insights into biomedicine and ELSA research in NRW
