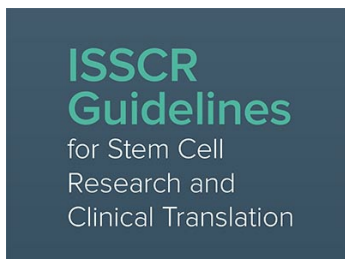
Extended deadline for early bird tickets and abstract submission
